It's a world of water! Tues Sept 13 – Saturday 29 October: Water themes, exhibit, and watershed education.

This month we'll feature kits like Save Our Streams, the watershed "enviroscape", our nature center pond; and have games, and art projects related to water, the water cycle, and how we can develop a closer bond with our water and watery creatures around us.

Saturday is kids discovery day for the entire family at the nature center.

Sat. 17 Sept. Follow the flow. 10am walk from the nature center along the water's path to the new mural on Draper rd. Enjoy the farmer's market following that to learn where your food comes from. The nature center is open 9am – 1pm.

Sat. 24 Sept. Learn about the flow of water and where pollution goes. What does a cigarette butt taste like?...We won't find out – but you will see what they all look like when they get into the water.

Sat. 1 Oct. Follow the flow to Tom's Creek. Meet at the Heritage Park upper parking lot (Glade Rd.) at 10:15 AM. Transportation is also available from the Price House at 10AM in the SEEDS van. If it's raining, we'll be enjoying the flow of water into our rain barrel and into the pond at the nature center.

Sat. 15 Oct. "Living Together – water and land". How do living things in water depend on each living things on land for all of our needs?

Sat. 22 Oct. Fall stories and featuring kids books with water themes.

Sat. 22 Oct. Fall has arrived, but Stroubles Creek keeps springing! 10am walk from the nature center to the spring.

Sat. 29 Oct. No tricks, but sometimes living things make it hard for us to see them. Camouflage day at the nature center. Wear your fall colors!
